Accessible Hiking within 1 hour of host hotel (Front Range Urban Corridor):

Please be mindful that at high elevations, hiking may be more strenuous because of lower oxygen concentrations in the air. Also be aware that during summer months, afternoon thunderstorms with lightning are common in the Rockies and/or the sun is strong.
