Clinic Reminders

Teaching Movement Analysis to Instructors via Skier Improvement Clinics

- 1. Movement analysis is a learned and practiced skill which we can improve upon, it's not an inherent trait.
- 2. When teaching movement analysis, try to teach specific skills that increase understanding of the group. Try not to just watch a video and point out everything that is "wrong."
- 3. Use specific drills to highlight specific movements and try to relate them back to the whole.
- 4. Movement analysis is the study of movement, not wrong or right. If something catches your eye that you like, speak up! People love to hear what they are doing right.
- 5. Having a specific focus on what you are trying to achieve keeps the conversation on topic and relevant. Make sure you have a focus.
