ADAPTIVE SHOOTING LEAGUE

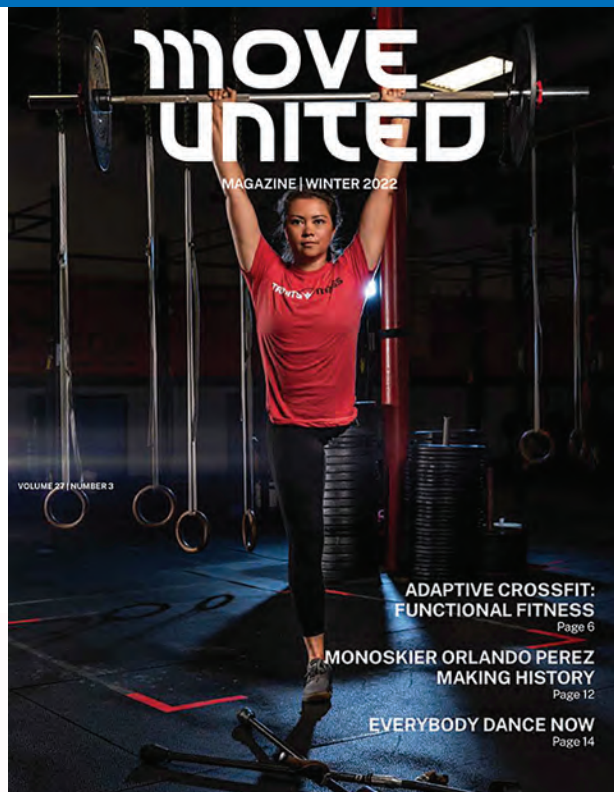

COMPETITION AND PARALYMPIC DEVELOP

MOVE UNITED SANCTIONED COMPETITIONS

Move United works alongside its nationwide member network to provide competition opportunities for youth and adults, including disabled Veterans and members of the Armed Forces. Specifically, the Move United Sanctioned Competitions Series includes over two dozen events annually, which vary in level and scope. These events serve over 2,000 unique athletes with a physical, visual and/or intellectual disabilities. They are training opportunities for national competitions such as National Governing Body National Championships, Trials, the National Veteran Wheelchair Games, the Valor and Warrior Games -and are qualifiers for the The Hartford Nationals. A complete list of events, locations, and contacts, is released each January for the competition season. Our network offers competition opportunities to grassroots, amateur level athletes all the way up the athlete pipeline to those elite level athletes competing or aspiring to compete on the world stage. DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE WARRIOR GAMES

The Department of Defense (DoD) holds an annual adaptive-sports competition, the Warrior Games, highlighting the exceptional physical skills and mental toughness of wounded, ill and injured active-duty and veteran service members. Men and women representing the U.S. Army, Marine Corps, Navy, Air Force, Space Force, Coast Guard and U.S. Special Operations Command compete in a variety of adaptive sports. dodwarriorgames.com

REQUIREMENTS

The VA National Veterans Sports Programs & Special Events Office provides a monthly training allowance for Veterans with disabilities who are training in Paralympic sports or Veterans with disabilities who are selected for or competing with the national Paralympic Team, as authorized under 38 U.S.C. 322(d).

1. ELIGIBILITY

A Veteran athlete must be nationally or internationally classified by his/her respective Paralympic sport federation to be eligible for Paralympic competition in that sport

OR

A Veteran athlete, with a service-connected disability rated 30 percent or greater by VA, must be selected for a national Olympic Team for any month in which the Veteran is competing in any event sanctioned by the National Governing Bodies of the U.S. Olympic Sport, in accordance with Public Law 114-223.

For both Olympic and Paralympic sports, the national sport organizations include the United States Olympic and Paralympic Committee, including its U.S. Paralympics Division and National Governing Bodies, and the equivalent organizations for American Samoa, Guam, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, Puerto Rico, and the United States Virgin Islands.



2. MEET THE PERFORMANCE STANDARD

To be eligible for the athlete stipend program, a Veteran with a qualifying disability must meet the minimum performance standards or higher (e.g., emerging athlete or national team) in his/her respective Paralympic sport at a recognized competition.

3. TRAINING PLANS

Athletes must have established training and competition plans and are responsible for turning in monthly and quarterly reports in order to continue receiving the monthly assistance allowance.

EQUIPMENT RESOURCES

APPLYING FOR ADAPTIVE EQUIPMENT

As a wounded service member, you may be eligible for adaptive equipment through the VA, whether you are active duty or a Veteran. The following is a brief guide to navigate the process for receiving adaptive equipment.

1. Register through the VA. blogs.va.gov/nvspse/training-allowances
2. Identify your interests. The process can move more quickly if you already have documentation of participation and trials of several pieces of adaptive equipment to know which one works best for you.
3. Consult your primary care provider. They will help initiate this process and make referrals as needed. Medical clearance is required.
4. Get a full evaluation. Typically done through the rehabilitation department, this assessment includes education and identification of adaptive equipment as it relates to your specific physical needs and interests.
5. Identify Appropriate Equipment/Submit Request. Based on the evaluation, you and your rehabilitation team will select equipment to accommodate your needs. Next, a formal request will be submitted for final approval.
6. Receive your equipment. Final fitting and adjustments are made when equipment is issued.
