

In 2024, 35 sanctioned competitions in 24 states will serve over 2,000 athletes of all ages and performance levels, including new athletes, Paralympians, and warfighters.

All events are qualifiers for The Hartford Nationals scheduled for July 12 - 18, 2024. Move United Sanctioned Competitions are an integral part of Move United's community-based adaptive sports movement, committed to leaving no one on the sidelines.
