- Strong partnerships with community, including but not limited to local sport organizations, CVB, etc.
- Experience hosting adaptive sport events
- Accessible venue(s) & hotel property
- Close proximity of hotel(s), sport-session venues, and/or airport
- Affordability of the event for participants

Preferences:

• Bids submitted on behalf of multiple groups collaborating (Ex. MU Member organization, university, local tourism agency &/or sports commission)

Education Conference Bid Deadline

Bids for 2026 and 2027 will be accepted until January 31st, 2025. If Move United receives a strong bid prior to the deadline, we reserve the right to move forward awarding the bid at an earlier date.

Please note that the location of the conference does change annually. While your organization may bid and be considered for both 2026 and 2027, it may not be awarded host partner status for both 2026 and 2027.

Established in 1956, Move United offers communitybased sports recreation, education and competition that push people further, bring people closer and leave no one on the sidelines.

Move United Education Conference Overview

The Move United Education Conference provides the tools and training to address emerging topics in the adaptive sports industry and to create recreational and competitive sport opportunities for individuals with disabilities. This event brings like-minded and goal oriented people together to effect long standing change around access and inclusion.

The event is comprised of several components, including classroom and interactive education sessions and workshops, an exhibitor hall, and socials, that we hope to host out of one centralized location. While many education sessions will take place in a classroom, we also strives to provide experiential sessions that may take place at venues such as a bike path, local gymnasium, lake, etc. Through the conference, Move United seeks to provide attendees with an experience authentic to the host organization and city.

The ideal timing of this conference is between late April and early May. Historically, the main conference days have been Monday - Wednesday or Tuesday - Thursday.

Responsibilities of the Host

- Facilitation of connections to local organizations
- Ensuring city/event venue accessibility is a priority
- Support in identifying and securing neccessary event venues
- Support in identifying and coordinating transportation needs as required
- Support in securing necessary event equipment (including but not limited to tables, chairs, and/or adaptive sports equipment)
- Support in meeting access needs of participants
- Market and promote event to local community members and organizations

Preferred:

- In-kind or discounted access to event venues
- In-kind or discounted access to venue equipment such as tables, chair, and/or audio/visual equipment
- Financial support of a social and/or venue-dependent needs such as transportation

- Day 1: Set-up and preparation
- Day 2: Set-up & preparation, pre-con. workshops
- Day 3: Pre-conference workshops continue
- Day 4: Main arrival day, Pre-conference workshops end, evening opening reception
- Day 5: Conference sessions, exhibitor hall, social
- Day 6: Conference sessions, exhibitor hall, social
- Day 7: Departure day
- **Event structure may change with growth of event



Venues

- Accessible venues desired (consider doorways, floor surface, ramps, restrooms, parking, etc.)
- Meeting space needs include:
 - General session space to accommodate 450 in rounds (Days 4-6)
 - 4 break-out rooms to accommodate 125 theatre (Days 5-6)
 - 3 rooms to accommodate 30 rounds (Days 1-7)
 - Space for 20 exhibitors (Days 5-6)
- Meeting/session space preferences include:
 - Indoor and/or outdoor sport court(s)
 - Pool
 - Rock wall
 - Track
 - Trail(s)
 - Ice rink

Note that need of specific venues will depend on the conference agenda. In your application, please note availability of additional sport facilities nearby (i.e. equestrian center, curling center, archery range etc.). It is preferable for the venue(s) to be walking/rolling distance to each other. If that is not possible, short driving distance (under 10 min.) is preferred.

- Accessible rooms will be most desired and all accommodations with accessible features prioritized.
- Hotel utilized for attendee check-in, pre-conference workshops, some conference sessions, networking events, and nerve center
- Meeting space needs include:
 - General session space to accommodate 450 in rounds
 - 3 Rooms to accommodate 30 rounds
- Food & beverage needs include:
 - Coffee 2 mornings

Quick Facts



Exhibitor Hall

- Space needed for 25-30 exhibitors, each with 1 6 ft x 18 inch table and 2 chairs, for the 2-day exhibitor hall
- Access to electricity preferred (not all exhibitors will need electricity)
- Space that is secure during non-exhibitor hours



Transportation

- Location near to major airport desired
- If hotel and session location(s) are not walking/rolling distance, accessible transportation solution desired



Dates

- Prefer late April/early May
- Prefer a Monday Wednesday or Tuesday Thursday for main conference
