- 5. Refer to the 5 fundamentals of alpine skiing.
- 6. There are no wrong answers. You are describing your observations.

- 8. If you understand body movements and their effects it doesn't matter what discipline you teach. The ski and ski to snow interaction doesn't change between disciplines.
- 9.
