WEATHER

February is typically cold in Flagstaff. Prepare for winter conditions by bringing plenty of base layers and long socks. HCAS provides ski clothing, helmets, goggles, gloves, heated vests, and gloves.

TRANSPORTATION

For those flying into Phoenix, we recommend using <u>Groome Transportation</u>. They will drop you off directly at your hotel.

Carpooling is encouraged within the group during lesson days. HCAS staff will be able to shuttle as well.

Ski/Ride Days

Ski/ride instruction will take place from 10 AM to 3 PM on Wednesday and Thursday, and from 10 AM to 12 PM on Friday. The expectation is that you show up everyday, with an open mind, and willingness to learn and improve your skills.
